Description and Details of Incident:

On Wednesday February 14, 2018 the Fort Lee Police Department responded to 1405 Teresa Drive for a report of a “peeping tom”. They met and spoke with the victim, a juvenile female and the victim’s Mother. Victim indicated that DeJesus was looking in her window as she was getting dressed. Dejesus was employed as the superintendent of the building at the time and utilized a ladder to access the victim’s window which was located on the second floor. Detective Nicholas Orta and Detective Thomas Keelen were assigned to the case and conducted an extensive investigation. DeJesus was transported to the Fort Lee Headquarters where he provided a statement regarding the incident. Based on evidence and the information during the investigation, DeJesus was placed under arrest and charged with Invasion of Privacy and Peering into Windows both are 4th Degree crimes.

DeJesus was release from custody with a Superior Court Return Date of March 2, 2018.
